Environmental and social risk management is subject to periodic audits and assurance.</p> <p>Origin operates its business in accordance with the HSE Management System through the HSE Management Directive and the HSE Risk Controls Directive mandates the minimum requirements for Origin business units to develop, implement and maintain an integrated system for the management of health, safety and environment risks and/or impacts. 102-12	External initiatives	<p>Ratings and awards</p> <p>Energy and climate change</p> <p>Human Rights Policy</p> <p>On 21 October 2015 Origin was the first energy company in the world to sign up to seven climate change initiatives under the global We Mean Business coalition.</p> <p>In 2017, Origin became the first Australian company to set an emissions reduction target approved by the Science Based Targets initiative, ensuring that our decarbonisation trajectory is in line with the 2°C Paris Agreement.</p> <p>Origin has participated in the annual CDP Climate Change survey since 2006, and was included in the FTSE4Good Index during the reporting period. Origin's level of sustainability disclosure was reviewed by the Australian Council of Superannuation Investors (ACSI) and assessed at a 'Leading' level within the Energy and Utilities sector for the last four years. A rating of 'Leading' demonstrates to investors that the company has consistently outperformed others in their sustainability disclosure, and seeks to ensure that their reporting on sustainability risks prioritises the needs of shareholders by addressing the range of material risks.¹ This level of reporting gives investors valuable information to inform their investment decisions. In 2018, Origin received a rating of AA (on a scale of AAA-CCC) in the MSCI ESG Rating assessment.²</p> <p>Origin commits to abiding by all applicable laws and regulations in the places we conduct our activities.
