



Previous feed-in tariffs

SA Solar Feed-in Scheme 44c/kWh rate

1 January 2008 - 30 September 2011

If you've got an eligible solar electricity system and successfully applied to the SA Solar Feed-In Scheme before 1 October 2011, you're eligible to receive a feed-in tariff of 44c/kWh.

You can remain on the scheme until 30 June 2028, as long as you continue to meet the relevant eligibility requirements.

The 44c/kWh SA Solar Feed-in Scheme closed to new participants on 30 September 2011.

If you're participating in this scheme, you're also eligible to receive our standard retailer feed-in tariff. This amount increased from 6.8c/kWh* to 11c/kWh* on 1 July 2017.

For SA Solar Feed-in Scheme customers switching electricity retailers or moving house

- If you intend to switch electricity retailers you should notify your new electricity retailer that you've got a solar electricity system at your property and that you're currently receiving the 44c/kWh feed-in tariff. The new electricity retailer must accept your status as a solar electricity customer and you can then continue receiving the 44c/kWh feed-in tariff.
- If you're moving into a property where the 44c/kWh feed-in tariff is in place, you're eligible to receive these feed-in tariffs.
- If you move out of a property, you won't remain eligible for the 44c/kWh tariff or at your new property you move to, as the feed-in tariffs remain attached to the original property.
