Queensland Solar Bonus Scheme - 44c/kWh rate

The 44c/kWh Queensland Solar Bonus Scheme (SBS) closed to existing applicants on 30 June 2013. For more details on the eligibility and application process, visit dews.qld.gov.au.

1 July 2008 to 9 July 2012

If you have an eligible solar electricity system and successfully applied to the QLD SBS between 1 July 2008 and 9 July 2012 you're eligible to receive a feed-in tariff (FIT) of 44c/kWh.

You can remain on the scheme until 30 June 2028 as long as you continue to meet the relevant eligibility requirements.

As an Origin customer, if you're participating in the 44c/kWh SBS you'll also receive our standard retailer FIT rate of 7c/kWh* from 1 July 2017, taking the total FIT to 51c/kWh for any solar electricity exported to the grid.

Important information about your eligibility for the 44c/kWh SBS

You need to know that the following changes at your property or to your electricity account can cause you to become ineligible for the 44c/kWh SBS:

- Upgrading or increasing the capacity of your inverter above the original inverter capacity stated in the original network connection agreement will automatically make you ineligible for the 44c/kWh SBS.

Account name changes: Electricity account name changes after 23 November 2012 result in loss of entitlement to the 44c/kWh SBS. This applies to adding a new person to your electricity account or to new customers or tenants moving into the property. The electricity distributor will automatically remove you from this scheme.

You may however add a current spouse to your account and remain eligible for the 44c/kWh SBS.

You can switch electricity retailers under the 44c/kWh SBS but you must ensure there are no changes to the account holder's name during the transfer process and that you continue to meet the relevant scheme eligibility requirements.
