Key Terminology

Daily supply charge	A charge that applies for supplying electricity to your premises for each day of the billing period, regardless of how much electricity you use.
kWh	A 'kWh' stands for kilowatt hour and is the unit of measurement for your electricity usage charges.

Discounts

Discounts	Discounts apply to the usage charges only and do not apply to the other charges such as the daily supply or GreenPower charges.
Base Discount	A 28% discount on the usage charges will apply for the Energy Plan period.
Credit	Sign up online and get a \$25 (incl. GST) credit applied towards the charges on your bill after 3 months of supply. Maximum credit of \$50 (incl. GST) credit per household. For residential customers only.

Agreement Details

Agreement length	The agreement continues until you or we end it. The Energy Plan period is 12 months. At the end of your Energy Plan the benefits of your plan will end but the agreement continues.
Charges may vary	We may vary the Charges (including the amount, nature and structure of any of the charges) by notice to you at any time. The notice could take the form of a message on your bill and will specify the effective date of the variation.
Cooling off period	You may cancel this agreement at any time during the 10 business day cooling off period.
Flexible Pricing Information	By choosing this tariff you may not be able to revert to your original tariff, but there will be a flat rate tariff available to you, except in some circumstances, which may include where you have a solar PV system.
