

Tips for Location of Indoor and Outdoor unit Locations

Whilst a pre installation inspection will be conducted to establish your installation requirements, it is important that to think about where both the indoor and outdoor units will be located. Some things to consider:

- ***Indoor Unit***
 - Select a location where children cannot reach the unit.
 - Select a place where the wall is strong enough to withstand the full weight and vibration of the unit.
 - Be sure to leave enough space to allow for routine maintenance – i.e. cleaning of filter.
 - The height of the installed location should be at least 1.8m above the floor.
 - Select a location that is about 1metre away from your TV or other electronic appliances.

- ***Outdoor Unit***
 - Select a location from which noise and outflow air emitted by the system will not inconvenience neighbours, animals and plants. Some local councils/planning authorities have rules regarding the maximum allowable noise levels emitted by air conditioner units – so please ensure that you check prior to installation.
 - The location should provide sufficient ventilation, free from obstruction of the inlet and outlet vents.
 - Ideally, select a dry place, one that does not expose the outdoor unit to direct sunshine or strong wind.
